

Fourth Grade Costume Checklist

You must be able to move easily and perform in the clothes you choose. No heels please. Most of what we’re looking for is free form. Please do not feel that you need to buy anything! Costume Closet has limited items but may be worth a fun visit. Please note that we have no dressing rooms and there is not enough time between your numbers to get to the restrooms. All costumes and accessories must be layered. Below is a list of what you will need for each number. Bring everything with you for **both** Dress Rehearsal and Show. Place it in a brown paper grocery bag with your name on both sides. This will be your “suitcase” for the show.

- ❑ **“California Here We Come”:** Mexican or Spanish attire such as sombreros, Mexican or Spanish attire such as sombreros, shawls, serapes, flowers or other exotic outfits. (Must be able to do movement while wearing attire) (We have 12 sombreros) Note: You will be wearing this same costume for your next number. *“Cielito Lindo” or “La Bamba”*
- ❑ **Rancheros Commentary and Skit Actors and Announcers:** Follow guidelines above, but add extra details that add to your character.
- ❑ **“Cielito Lindo” Same as Above “La Bamba:** Same as above
- ❑ **“On My Way” and Gold rush skits:** Gold rush outfits as a prospector might wear. Boots, western hats, bandanas, suede, checkered shirts. Think old and worn out. You can find pictures in your social studies book or on many websites (PBS is good) (We have bandanas for everyone)
- ❑ **“Do Re Mi”** Dust bowl, migrant worker attire such as 1930 hats, suspenders, overalls, rolled up jeans with dusty work boots, bandanas, dusty collared shirts, bonnets for girls.
- ❑ **“If You Want to be a Star” and Hollywood Skits: Your best “Star” look. Can be as simple as a pair of sunglasses or a glittery scarf. (Girls in those skits will wear our feather boas** (Have 6 extra boas to lend)
- ❑ **“Soak Up the Sun ”, Surf Skit and Travel agency Skits:** Beach attire such as board shorts, rash guards, aloha shirts, beach hats etc. (We have plenty of sunglasses if you want to borrow)
- ❑ **Closing Songs:** Continue to wear your beach clothes as above.
